

1. Go to the church website at [www.intersectionchurch.com](http://www.intersectionchurch.com) and put your mouse over the "Media" link at the top of the page and select "Sermons" from the drop down menu that appears.
2. On the new page that opens, you will see a black box with small picture tiles. These are all of the sermon series. Click on each tile to scroll through all of the available sermon series.
3. To listen to a sermon in any particular series, double click on the sermon series tile of your choice. The name of the series appears on the tiles, as well as below the tiles in the top left of the white box. Once one series is selected, several other tiles should appear in the box at the top of the page if there is more than one sermon in that series. If only one tile remains, there is only one sermon in the series. To select one specific sermon, click the tile you want. The name of the sermon displays below the tiles in the middle of the white box.
4. After selecting the sermon you wish to listen to, view the white box below and read through the list of options displayed on the right side of the page. You will see links for downloading, listening, and sharing. If a link is light gray, it is not available.
  - a. To listen to a sermon in your browser window, click the "Listen" link and the sermon will begin.
  - b. To download an mp3, click the "Download" link and look near the top of the screen for a small gray box to appear. If you don't immediately see the box, scroll up to find it. Click the "Audio" button to start the download.
    - i. PC Users - Type in your own file name and add .mp3 to the end of the file name to save as an mp3. Your file name should look like this: *myfavoritesermon.mp3* Select the download folder below the filename and then click save. The sermon will be saved in the folder of your choosing and is then able to be played or transferred to your favorite MP3 player.
    - ii. Mac Users- Type your own file name, but the file should automatically save as an mp3. You should see .mp3 at the end of the suggested file name, so you only need to change the name of the file. Select the download folder below the file name and then click save. The sermon will be saved in the folder of your choosing and is then able to be imported into iTunes.
  - c. You have the option of sharing the link to the sermon either on Facebook, Twitter, or via email.
    - i. Email - Click the "Email to a friend link", which will open up an email box. You will need to fill out the box completely and then click "Send".
    - ii. Facebook or Twitter - Click on the share link of your choice and you will be redirected to your profile in a new tab or browser window. Follow the normal sharing procedure for that service to post a link to your profile.
