

Cancellation of church events due to inclement weather

In the event that a snowstorm, other inclement weather, requires a Sunday morning service, or a church sponsored event to be cancelled, there are a number of ways you can be notified of the cancellation. Please review the options below and choose one that best meets your needs.

1. A church-wide email will be sent out through CCB. If you are not signed up to CCB, please email leahdwyer@intersectionchurch.com to sign up. You may also visit <https://intersectionchurch.ccbchurch.com/app/login.php> and sign up. Click the "Sign up" link below the login in section to request a username and password. We will email all people registered in CCB with a cancellation notice. We encourage everyone to be signed up with CCB to ensure that you are always getting the most up to date information.

2. Check the church website. Go to www.intersectionchurch.com and move your mouse pointer over the "Events" link on the top of the page. Please click on the "Cancellations" link and you will be taken to the cancellations page. The event cancellation details will be listed on that page.

3. We will send out text alerts. If you have a mobile phone capable of texting and wish to receive text alerts, you can sign up in CCB to receive texts. Please note that you MUST sign up in CCB for this service to receive the texts, as this is the only way we will send out text alerts. Instructions for this are on the following page.

4. Check the news on local television station WMUR for information about Sunday morning service cancellations. Please note that the stations will only cover Sunday morning services, not any other church sponsored events such as youth, Plugged In, meetings, or music practice.

**If you do not have access to text, TV, or email, but do have a telephone, we strongly encourage you to identify another person in the church whom you could call in the event of a storm. We would suggest you set up a "buddy" system so you have someone to call, or arrange for him/her to call you if needed. If the weather is bad and you are concerned that service may be cancelled, this is the best way to ensure you receive the information.

Signing up to receive text alerts for event cancellations in CCB

1. Log into CCB by visiting this link: <https://intersectionchurch.ccbchurch.com/app/login.php> If you are not already signed up, you can click the “Sign up” link below the login in section to request a username and password.
2. Click on the “Go to my profile” link on the top right of the screen. This link is located in a gray box that includes your profile picture (if you have one). The link will be below the “Welcome (your name)” message.
3. When you get to your main profile page, you will see your name and basic contact details. On the far right there will be a section titled “Actions”. In this section, you will see a number of links that will allow you to change and control your profile. Click on the “Set communications prefs” link, under the “Profile Settings” section. You will use this area to control how we communicate with you through CCB.
4. In the “Communication Settings” section, you will see a table with a list of groups you are part of and options for controlling what information is sent to you from each group. The fourth column is titled “Send me text messages from group leaders”. In this column, you have the option to select your mobile carrier and enter your phone number. If you wish to receive text alerts, click the drop down menu under the heading “Mobile Carrier” and select your carrier (Verizon, Sprint, etc...) and then enter your cellphone number, including area code, in the box below. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the “Save Settings” button. This will bring you back to your profile.
5. Click on the “Set communications prefs” link, under the “Profile Settings” section again. Scroll down, the groups you are a part of are listed on the left side of the page. For each group that you wish to allow to send you texts, click the check box in the fourth column that corresponds with the group. Select the box for “Intersection Church” group and this will enable you to receive text messages about event cancellations. You may then select any additional boxes in this column to enable text messages from other groups.
6. Scroll to the bottom of the page and click the “Save Settings” button on the right to save any changes. You will be returned to your profile and the following message will show at the top of the screen: “Communications settings were successfully updated”. Now, if a text is sent out to church attendees, you will receive it. Anytime you wish to change your settings, follow these instructions to log in again and check or uncheck the desired boxes in the fourth column and save the changes.
